Riesling

Tracing its origin to the Rhine regions of Germany this highly aromatic white grape distinguished by a vibrancy on the palate. Ranging from the crisp zest of citrus to revealing a garden of floral notes, all while boasting minerality that whispers of the land where the grapes have taken root. Chardonnay

With roots that stretch across the wine-producing realms, this varietal holds court as the king of versatility and minerality. From the chalky soils of Burgundy to the stony terroirs of Chablis, each sip is a journey through the very essence of the earth from which it springs. Capable of expressing a wide spectrum of styles from unoaked labels that mirror the freshness of a mountain spring, to buttery opulence that defines the Chardonnay of sun-drenched vineyards and oak-barrel aging, leaving a lingering, velvety finish on the palate.
